▶ **ACADEMIC SUPPORT SERVICES:**

Proctor is proud to offer academic support within a rigorous college preparatory curriculum. Learning Skills and Learning Lab programs are available to a limited number of students at additional cost. More detailed course information is outlined in the Academic Course Descriptions found in the Viewbook. If you have specific questions about these programs, we invite you to ask an admission officer.

Learning Skills supports students of strong aptitude who would benefit from assistance with organization, time-management, study strategies, academic skills, self-advocacy and academic coaching. Learning Skills meets four times a week in a 2:1 student-to-faculty ratio. Recent psycho-educational testing, such as a WISC, WIAT, Woodcock-Johnson or a language evaluation must be provided in the application process to make an accurate assessment of whether the applicant can be well-served within this program.

Learning Lab is a study skills course designed to assist students in their transition to Proctor's academic program. The Lab experience can be for one or more terms. A broad emphasis is placed on, but not limited to, organizational skills and time management. Learning Lab has an 8:2 student-to-instructor ratio and holds four classes weekly.
